## Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)

We have been granted planning permission and now the project really gets started. We are researching funding sources and will be seeking parishioners views in the near future on uses for the enclosed sports surface for all ages and abilities.

Part of the plan is to use the soil spoil to create a bank of vegetation to add to the biodiversity of the Recreation Field, without encroaching upon existing playing areas, but to enhance the whole area.
