No new planning applications from Huntingdonshire District Council have been received.

There have been two updates to Cambridgeshire County Council application in regard to the proposed bio-digester – ref CCC/25/107/FUL – 1) road safety response sheet 2) alternative access from B660

The Council have, however, been informed of a North Northants planning application in regard to the proposed bio-digester - ref NN/23/00026/WASFUL - Rectory Farm, Gypsy Lane, Luddington In The Brook.

This was discussed at the Parish Council meeting with input from 8 further people from Great Gidding.

The Council have reiterated their objections to North Northants Council.
